



MRL Export Risk Survey

Dear Sir/Madam,

Thank you in advance for your participation in this Canada Grain Council survey.

The Canada Grains Council has been engaged for more than 2 ½ years in an initiative on maximum residue limit (MRL) advisories that has brought together key organizations in the Canadian grain value chain to agree on a predictable, consistent approach for making annual MRL recommendations to growers. The intent of that policy is to provide a balance between enabling the commercialization of new chemistries/registrations while ensuring that exports from Canada are not exposed to unacceptable trade risk.

As part of this, an effort is underway to examine the feasibility of new risk management or insurance solutions for potential rejection of shipments by importing countries because of MRLs that are set at lower levels than Canada's MRLs, or even set at zero. You can help with this by filling out the survey, which will contribute toward the potential development of a new risk financing/transfer product to help manage these risks.
